Levi Aldrich, aged ninety years, died this morning at eleven o'clock at his home, 2117 Marshall Avenue. Death was due to old age. Mr. Aldrich had been ill for a short time only, having had sufficient strength to enable him to make a visit on Saturday to the business district.

" HIS LIFE IS CRUSHED OUT "

" O. N. Aldrich, Car Inspector, Meets instant Death in Yards Sunday Night "

#### LONG IN THE SERVICE

Funeral Service From Residence, 2213 Marshall, on Tuesday Afternoon--Burial in Dodge Grove.

O. N. Aldrich, car inspector of the Illinois Central railroad, on the night force of the switching department, met instant death at twelve o'clock on Sunday night, crushed and mangled between the coupling irons of two cars in the Illinois division yards. This is the third accident of this nature on divisions ending in Mattoon that has happened within a month, all three fatal.

Inspector Aldrich, best known to his fellows as "Newt" Aldrich, was a veteran in the service of the Mattoon terminal yards. He was a member of the crew, and Sunday night the engine with which he worked was sent into the Illinois division yards to take a baggage car out of train No. 6, which arrived from Chicago about one hour late.

#### Life is Crushed Out.

The car was detached and the engine was shunting it hurriedly onto the wye track north of union station. It is said that Aldrich was riding the end of the car, clinging to the coupling apparatus. A freight car stood on the wye, and either he did not know of its immediate proximity in the darkness, or believed he was a safe distance from it. His body was caught squarely between the couplers and his chest and abdomen were crushed. Death was instantaneous.

The F. S. Schilling ambulance was called and a surgeon was summoned, but it was too late. The body was taken to the Schilling morgue, where it was dressed. At ten o'clock this morning Coroner J. H. McClelland of Charleston called a jury for the inquest.

#### Long in Central Employ.

O. N. Aldrich was one of the best known men in car inspecting service in Mattoon. He was a native of Olney, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Levi Aldrich, living now at 2213 Marshall Avenue. He had never married and resided with his father, caring for him. For a time the family farmed near Olney. Later they moved to a farm near Neoga, then to Coles, and about twenty years ago came to Mattoon, when Newton Aldrich entered the Illinois Central service.

Had he lived until July Mr. Aldrich would have been fifty-two years old. His service with the company had been continuous and he was one of the most valued employees. He was well known throughout the city and had many friends.
