He was in the Army of Virginia up to March 12, 1865. On March 3rd 1865 after being wounded he was put in the hospital at Camp Harrison near Richmond, VA. He was captured by the Yankees when they over ran and captured Camp Harrison. He was then taken to Point Lookout, MD and exchanged for a Yankee prisoner. He had been wounded and was near death or he would not have been exchanged. He was then taken to Jackson Confederate Army Hospital in Richmond, Virginia where he died on March 12, 1865. He was buried in Section W, grave #147, of the Soldiers' Section at Hollywood Cemetery in Richmond Virginia. [George & Aletha Norris Crouch. FTW]

### JACKSON GENERAL HOSPITAL

Located "in the western suburbs beyond Hollywood Cemetery." It was bounded by the present City streets of Idlewood Avenue on the north, Jacquelin Street on the south, Allen Avenue in the west, and Lombardy Street in the east. A common military road (present Allen Avenue) joined it with Winder Hospital. Opened 29 June 1863 "midway between Camp Lee and Winder". It had 40 acres of gardens and an excellent library. Original capacity was 1980, but it was reported to have been enlarged to, or able to handle, 2500. 9 May 1864 it was reported to be "filled with North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia troops from the battles" in northern Virginia. Named for General Thomas J. Jackson. It had 49 buildings.

Furnished three companies of Negro Confederate troops from amongst employees. They served "in the lines under fire" and had "a public drill in the Capitol Square" along with those from Winder Hospital. Their company commanders were: Captains A. Lockett, W. M. Baxley, and T. R. Calvin, in March 1865. Used by Federal occupation forces until 30 September 1865 for Confederate prisoners.

Charley L. Goins is the child of Martha Crouch Goins and an unknown father. He took the name of Goins , but since John Lewis Goins had been killed in the Civil War on December 15, 1864, and Charley L. was born to Martha Crouch Goins in 1877 it would be biologically impossible for him to have been sired by John Lewis Goins. Charley and his mother and brother Seaborne T. Goins were counted in the Cobb County Census in 1880. It is felt that she went there to hid the fact that she was having a child out of wedlock. She was back in Columbus, Muscogee County, GA. in 1890, and she applied for a Pension from the State of Georgia based on her husband John L. Goins Civil War Service. The Pension was granted in 1891 and continued each year throught the year of 1907. This is the year she probably died.

Joel W Lavender, 90, 1801 Wildwood Ave. whose career with the Columbus Post Office spanned more than four decades, died Tuesday at the Medical Center. Funeral will be today at 4 p.m. in the East Highland Primitive Baptist Church, with burial in Parkhill Cemetery. A self described "Post Office man" through and through, Lavender began as a letter carrier and worked his way up to supervisor of letter carriers. He then became assistant superintendent of mails, a position he held at the time of his retirement 20 years ago. He described that last position as a "troubleshooter" job. When he started out, there were a scant 15 letter carriers in all of the city, but by the time he hung up his hat, there were more. than 100. Bradley's mother and daddy died when he was four years old. He and his brother Cecil Barnes Boland were taken

in by their grandfather Thomas Pryor Barnes And he took them to live with him at his daughter's home in Bronwood, Georgia. Their grandfather (Tip Barnes) paid his daughter Otis Barnes Gamage room and board for the three of them to live at her home. Tip owned a mercantile store in that town. Bradley and Cecil lived with their grandfather at their Aunt Otis' home until their grandfather died rather suddenly from Erysipelas. After Bradley's grandfather died and there was no one to continue paying board for Bradley and Cecil Aunt Otis and Uncle George Gamage requested that the Boland family take the children and raise them. They first went to their grandfather Boland's home in Midway, Muscogee Co., Georgia, and then Uncle Jerry Boland took both of them to live with him in Elba, Coffee County, Alabama. Bradley and Cecil attended school while school was open but the country school would close for the children to help plant the farm crops and during harvesting time. Bradley's Uncle Jerry owned and operate a large sawmill. It was Bradley's job to get up about four o'clock each morning and walk the two miles to the sawmill and get the fire started in the boiler so the men could start right to work when they arrived to work. After Bradley got the boilers working he then went on to school. Bradley was a natural born mechanic. It seemed like he could fix anything mechanical. One afternoon, after Bradley had reached his 13th birthday, Bradley, Cecil and Uncle Jerry were stopped at he country store on their way home. While they were there a Mr. McCart from Liberty Church, near Elba, Alabama came in and made a statement that there would be no more cotton ginned until he could get a man from Contininal Gin Co. in Birmingham down to fix his cotton gin. Uncle Jerry said, "let Bradley take a look at it he is good at fixing things". Mr. McCart said, " he is welcome to look but I don't see what a 13 year old boy can do to fix something that I have to always get an engineer from the factory to fix." Bradley went in and started checking out the mill machinery. He hadn't gone very far with his examination until he discovered the problem and within a few minutes he had the mill running and they started ginning again. Mr. McCart was so pleased that he asked Bradley if he wanted a full time job. Bradley said, yes sir I could use a job that paid me money." Uncle Jerry asked what about school. Mr. McCart said he would work him during ginning season and he'd need him at the oil mill when they were running cotton seed and peanuts through the oil mill, but finally Mr. McCart agreed for Bradley to keep up with his school work as he worked for him. This way Bradley was able to finish high school. Bradley worked for Mr. McCart all through school. About that time Uncle Jerry sold his saw mill to his brother George Gabrie Boland. Uncle George took the sawmill to Omaha, Georgia where he had contracted to cut eight million board feet of lumber for the Cooper Lumber Co. of Columbus, Georgia. Uncle George could not get his mill hands to reach their quotas for saw logs and he was falling behind on his contract. Uncle George went to talk to Uncle Jerry to see if there was anything he could suggest that he could do. Uncle Jerry told him to go hire Bradley to run the mill. He said,"Bradley will put that mill to humming." Bradley was eighteen years old by this time and was still working for Mr. McCart, and other farmers in Brandley County. Uncle George hired Bradley to manage and operate his saw mill in Omaha, Stewart Co., Georgia. His first day on the job he called in all his sawers and told them they were to cut X number of saw log each day. They made a statement that it awas impossible to cut that many logs in one day. Bradley countered with they were not to come in to the mill or go home until that many logs were down with their mark on the base of the log. The first day some of the older loggers had cut their Quota of logs by six o'clock but some of the younger loggers were up to eight o'clock finishing. It wasn't long however before they all had their quotas by regular quitting time. Bradley put the mill to humming and they were meeting their contract right on time. Bradley was working from can to can't, meaning from sunup until dark every day. When Bradley was twenty years old he saw a pretty young lady at church, and at the next church social where the ladies brought a meal for two and the meals were auctioned off to the highest bidder Then the winner of the basket would get to eat the meal with the girl who fixed the meal. Bradley had found out that the pretty girl he had seem at church was Annie Lois Goins, and she was sixteen years old, and it was said that old man Goins would shoot anyone trifling with her. Bradley successfully bid in her lunch basket that night and was soon visiting her at her home. When Lois was seventeen and Bradley was Twenty-one he asked here to marry him. She said yes but he'd have to get her father's ok. Bradley went out in the yard one morning to ask Mr. Goins for his blessing. Mr. Goins was cutting stove wood and when Bradley said, "Mr. Goins Lois an I want to get married and I hope you will give us your blessing. " Mr. Goins said, "NO! HELL NO!" To which Bradley replied Mr. Goins, I was man enough to ask you for Lois in a proper manner, and since you take this attitude I want to tell you we are going to get married anyway." Bradley and Lois went to Columbus and on December 25, 1915 Bradley and Lois were married. Thomas Jefferson Boland, Bradley's first cousin, was his best man. After Uncle George shut down the saw mill Bradley got a job as a fireman for the Georgia Southern and Florida Railroad. That was prior to 1917. He went back to Alabama in 1917 and farmed and worked for the farmers in that part of Alabama. In 1919 he worked for the Seaboard Airline Railroad. Then in 1920 the owner Mr. Walter Rylander offered him the job as shop foreman for the Ford Motor Company in Richland, Georgia. Before 1924 he moved his family to Columbus, Georgia. There he opened a garage and worked on automobiles. He also had a gasoline station as a part of his shop operation. The family were members of the Wynnton Methodist Church in Columbus. In 1934 Bradley left Columbus and moved his family to Pahokee, Florida. He worked for the International Harvester Company. Bradley was with Glades Equipment Co. in Pahokee and after they moved to Belle Glade , Fla. and changed their

name to Glades Grove and Equipment Co. until September 10, 1984. He retired on his 90th birthday. He then continued living at the family home place at 2727 Bacom Point Road Pahokee, Fla. In the spring of 1987 Bradley moved to a small house that was owned by his daughter Sara Kate Boland Griffith in West Palm Beach, Fla. She wanted him near her so she could look after him. On May 12th 1987 Bradley died in his sleep it was his ninety third year. Bradley and Lois are buried at Parkhill Cemetery In Columbus, Ga.

Mary Elizabeth Storey, known to most of us as Betty, was born in Columbus, Georgia, on August 12, 1913. She was the fourth and last child of Charles Henry and Emma Maude Storey.

Early on, Betty exhibited some traits that would characterize her entire life. From her parents she learned that hard work carried its own benefits and that "a place for everything and everything in its place" was a worthwhile cause. A spirit of adventure was evident in her adventures down the railroad track as a small child. From her older sister and her two brothers, she learned that sometimes it was more fun to buy special things with the nickel meant for the bus, even when it meant a long walk to school.

Betty's sister, Irma, had a profound impact on her life when she finished grade school. Irma persuaded her parents to send Betty to Graysville, a self-supporting school and the predecessor to Southern Adventist College, near Chattanooga, Tennessee. It was here that Betty obtained a good Christian education and met her future husband, Marshall. Tomorrow (May 29, 2001) it will be sixty-three years since they wed.

Marshall and Betty moved to Miami, Florida, in 1939, and four years later they moved to Nashville, Tennessee. Marshall was drafted into the Army soon after their arrival, and it was in Nashville that their first daughter, Betty Sue, was born. Three years later Marsha Jo would join them, and the family would be complete. Sue and Marsha were special joys to Betty and her love for them was always evident. Betty taught Sabbath School frequently, following the girls as they made their way through the divisions. Betty took great care in preparing and cutting out the felts of people, animals, and scenes that brought the Bible alive to her young charges.

In 1948, Marshall went back on active duty, with Betty's encouragement. Betty was loyal, not only to her family and her marriage, but to her country as well. That patriotism was tested in 1952 when Marshall received orders for Korea. When she and the girls said good-bye, with only nine days notice, they had no idea how long he would be gone. Marshall stayed in Korea for 18 months, and they were long, hard months for Betty and the girls. The time was made somewhat easier by the loving hospitality given by Irma and Dick, who opened their Maryland home to the family. Marshall returned home from Korea in 1954 and the family remained in Maryland during his nine years at Walter Reed Army Medical Center. A labor of love began for Betty as she opened their home almost every Sabbath to young soldiers and their families.

In 1963, the Army decided that Marshall's abilities were needed in Germany, so the family packed their bags and started off on another adventure. The tour in Germany was hard on Betty - language barriers, inadequate housing, and the food. Betty skillfully made do with a small electric skillet and a big heart, for she still opened their home to soldiers and their families.

The Kirkhams eventually returned to Maryland, and were finally able to put down some roots. Marshall worked two jobs and Betty helped out with the college bills by working for ten years at Washington Adventist Hospital as



a librarian. Her joys continued to be times with her family, and when the girls choose their mates, Stuart and Gerald, Betty had no difficulty welcoming them into the growing family.

During the last five or six years of illness and trial, Betty's family and friends have been especially dear to her. Betty had cared for others, and now it was her turn to be cared for. Marshall never flagged in his devotion to Betty, often at the expense of his own health. Of course, Marshall didn't care for Betty alone, Sue and Marsha, with the loving support of their husbands, would drive long distances to be with Betty and were often on the phone checking on them. And there were others who came by and provided spiritual and emotional support and comfort, too numerous to mention. Until she died a few short days ago, Betty experienced the love and presence of Jesus through the faithful, constant care of those who loved her.

Betty is survived by her loving husband, Marshall, their two daughters and their husbands, Betty Sue & Gerald Bond and Marsha Jo & Stuart Williams, three grandchildren, Scott, Laura, and Bradley. She is also survived by her sister, Irma Brown, and many friends at Spencerville Church.
