Yes, there is a problem with the dates that I haven't completely worked through yet. Edwin states in the 1900 census that he was born in December 1840, but I don't really think it is correct (though its the date I happened to use on this response). Based on data from the earlier census listings, I would think he was born around 1842 or 1843 since in 1850 he was 8, 1860 he was 17, and in 1880 he was 38.

I have somewhat similar issues with Levi, who while consistently appearing to show he was born in 1838/39 (ie: 11 in 1850, 21 in 1860, 41 in 1880, then shows himself as being born in August 1841 in 1900, and then is shown as 80 in 1920).

I probably should have brought these issues up in the original note, but it didn't seem to be needed based on the info request that I was responding to.

As to Elmeda vs Emelda....oops..I looked at one word and typed another. Sorry about that.

Edwin L. Washburn's death certificate [Ottawa Co., MI] states that he was born 23 Dec 1840 in NY

His enlistment papers say he was born 23 Dec 1840 in Gouverneur, St. Lawrence Co., NY So I think that is valid proof of his birth date and place.

So that leaves Levi to wonder about!

Could be. Personally, I put a lot of weight on census records for small children. Parents rarely seemed to get the

ages too far off when the children are under 10. It also seems strange that Edwin was never listed as 9, 19, 29, 39, etc in the census listings, which would have been the case with a December 1840 birthday. Instead it was always a number ending in 7 or 8.

My gut feel is he was born in 1841 and he rounded that back to 1840 for some reason. Don't know why though since he should not have had to fudge his age to enlist in the army (some of my other Washburn relatives did because they were too young...it amazing seeing them suddenly get 3 years older!).

Without a record of his birth, it will never be known for sure unfortunately.

Grandpa Sheldon Russell Curtiss was born near Columbia, Lorain Co., Ohio. His childhood days were very pleasant. In his own words he writes that he was blessed with a precious father and mother and five dear sisters who gave him the tenderest care.

One of his earliest recollections was the music in his home. His father played the flute, fife, bass viol and drums. Grandpa Sheldon speaks on how much this music did captivate him. When he was older, he

would walk to church at Oberlin, Ohio. He found it an easy task to walk the two miles every Sunday to enjoy the music of the wonderful orchestra and listen to the choir with their splendid songs.

The Sabbath School always celebrated together on the fourth of July. Grandpa remembered that on one of these occasions his mother made him a beautiful flag. Grandpa was sure she would not need to take second place with the honored Betsey Ross when it came to making flags!

Fishing was a wonderful delight to him. There was a beautiful creek running across his father's place which was well filled with fish. He found it very convenient to sit on the big tree which had fallen across the stream and catch a fine bunch for the family meal. Of course, Grandpa said that his mother could cook them just right and that he had never tasted better fish than those were!

Another of Grandpa Sheldon's pastimes was going to mill for his father. Uncle Samuel Hoadley was the miller. The Hoadley Mills were noted the country around. Grandpa Curtiss would carry his grist on horseback about two miles through the woods and two miles in the clearing. If the grist had happened to fall off my horse he was too small to reload it, but this never worried him.

Finally, Grandpa Sheldon's father sold their early home and came to Michigan. It was very hard for Sheldon to bring his mind to this. Knowing that his dear mother could hardly bear the thought of leaving her father and mother and her comfortable home for a home in the wilderness, made it doubly hard for Grandpa Sheldon. The family started in the fall of the year with two teams heavily loaded. Grandpa Sheldon's two oldest sisters and their husbands had two more teams so it made quite a caravan. Grandpa's grandparents followed them to Michigan in a few years so we were together again.

In his sketch of "When Berlin and I Were Young," he told of meeting the beautiful girl in the old log school house at Berlin Center. She came with her parents from New Albion, New York, about one and one half years after they came from Ohio. Her name was Abigail Nancy Barnard, daughter of James and Elizabeth Barnard. Grandpa Sheldon and Abigail were married when he was twenty-one and she nine months younger, and they settled in a little home south of Berlin Center, Ionia Co., Michigan. In this home their oldest child, Rosalia Elizabeth was born.

The following is from Grandpa Sheldon Curtiss' s diary:

My first vote was cast for Abraham Lincoln in 1960. In 1862 he called for volunteers and I soon enlisted. We young soldiers sang in those days, "We are coming Father Abraham, 300,000 strong." Our flag had been fired upon at Fort Sumpter. The leaders of the Confederacy had endeavored to trail our flag in the dust and if we had consented to this our Country would have been divided against itself. We felt that duty demanded us to defend our Country in this terrible Civil War. It meant more than we can express to leave home and our precious family and take up arms against our countrymen in the South land. Lincoln had seen the awful curse of slavery and when he saw the poor victims tied to the whipping posts and whipped until the blood streamed down their backs he said, "If I ever get a chance I will strike that thing a blow and I will strike it hard." Slavery was one of the worst curses that ever existed in this country. Families were divided, sold and separated. Very often the beastly master was father of his own slaves and like LaGree in "Uncle

Francis was the youngest child of Joseph Barnard and Abigail Griswold. Francis moved to Simsbury, CT. from Windsor, CT., sometime before 1743 as the birth of his first daughter is recorded in the Simsbury town records. The family eventually occupied a house built in 1760 in the part of Bloomfield that was then a part of Simsbury. He was a full member of the First Church of Christ (Congregational) in Simsbury at the time of the ordination of Rev. Samuel Stebbens on 9 Dec 1777.

All of the seven sons of Francis and Lucretia served in the American Revolutionary War. Their house at 174 Duncaster Rd, is one of the historic houses listed in From Wintonbury to Bloomfield. For many years a sign in front read: "From this house went forth seven sons to fight in the American Revolution." Due to poor condition the house was razed in 1989 and the vacant lot was made into a mini-park. It was engaged at the Battle of White Plains on 28 Oct 1776. Its enlistments expired on 25 Dec. 1776.

Francis married Hannah Meruell on 15 Aug 1644 and may have been married to Mary Watson, who died in 1642.
