A Final Tribute

The angle of death has again invaded our family sanctuary and this time claimed for its victim her who gave us birth. It is sad.....

Our mother Serena Allen McPherson was born in East Tennessee--Rhea County we believe--and at

time of her death which occurred on 23rd near Benton, Saline County, Arkansas, was, we recollect right, about 72 years of age. She has one brother, yet living, Rev. Samuel A. Johnson, who resides near Blanco, Texas.

Away out here in the Indian Territory, far from the home of our childhood, and those who knew us in our younger days, we mourn, in silence and alone, for our sainted mother. Farewell, dear Ma, sometimes, before long, we will all be gathered together again in that better land above, where sickness, and sorrows never come, and where death will pat us not more.

Notes for GRANVILLE MCPHERSON:

Granville McPherson was born in Tennessee. Educated in common schools and at an early age was apprenticed to a printer. He went to Little Rock, AR where he was employed on the Herald and afterwards on the Advocate where he became acquainted with Albert Pike from whom he received his Masonic instructions. He belonged to the Magnolia Lodge #60 of Little Rock until he demitted on April 24, 1863. He went to Ft. Smith in about 1870. Captain McPherson obtained his title during the Civil War. He was sent to Indian Territory to assist in preserving order there under Gen. Maxey, and after the war closed he was stationed there and engaged in merchandising, and also founded a paper, the "Star Vindicator". He settled at Caddo, OK then the principal railroad point between Parsons and Dennison. In 1872 Granville and Dr. D. M. Haily produced weekly editions of "The Star" but the newspaper did not occupy all of his time. He organized a Masonic Lodge. After he left Caddo, Indian Territory, and moved to Blanco, Texas his name appears on the Masonic roll of Blanco Lodge #216. In 1878 the paper was moved to Blanco, TX and published by Granville and Beverly J. Watson. Granville soon took ill and operation was taken over by his wife Mary Kate along with her young son Lee J. Rountree and nephew, Emmett M. Watson. Upon the death of Captain Granville McPherson in 1887, Mary Kate moved the paper to nearby Kyle, TX. Later, she opened a second "Star Vindicator" in San Marcos, TX leaving the Kyle paper in the able hands of her son Lee J. Rountree. In 1964 the Grand Lodge of Oklahoma, through members of Blanco Lodge finally located his grave and they erected a tombstone with all of the proper inscriptions on it and with the square and compass design on it. The grave was located through the efforts of Mrs. Ollie Sanders (Milo). She died a few days after drawing a map of the location of the grave. Had they been just one month later the grave would have never been located.

Notes for LYDIA ANN STARR:

Lydia Starr McPherson, journalist, was born in 1827 in Warnock, Ohio, the daughter of William F. and Sarah (Lucas) Starr. She moved with her family to Iowa at the age of twelve and began teaching school at Ashland, Iowa, when she was seventeen. On May 2, 1849, she married David Hunter and settled with him near Keosauqua, Iowa, where they had five children. After Hunter's death, Lydia moved with her three sons to Oskaloosa, Iowa, and then to Caddo, Indian Territory, in 1874, and

married Granville McPherson, owner of the Oklahoma Star. Together they edited the Star, for which she wrote under the pen name Urania, until Granville moved the paper to McAlisterville in the Indian Territory in 1876. In 1878 he moved to Blanco, Texas, where he died. Lydia remained behind in Caddo and began publication of the Caddo International News, under her own editorial direction, with her sons as printers. The following year she moved her family to Whitesboro, Texas, and established the weekly Whitesboro Democrat, the first newspaper in Texas owned and operated by a woman. In 1879 she and her sons were invited to transfer operation to Sherman, and the new Sherman Democrat, which became a daily in 1881, developed into a profitable and influential paper. Lydia McPherson joined the Texas Press Association in 1881, one of the first three women members, and served as corresponding secretary. She was a delegate to the World's Exposition in New Orleans in 1885, and from 1886 to 1890 she served as postmistress of Sherman. She contributed to Cosmopolitan magazine, the Toledo Blade, Youth's Companion and the Chicago Advance, among others, and wrote poems and novels; her only published volume was Reullura (1892), a collection of poetry. In 1890 she toured the western and Pacific states and sent travel letters to the Sherman Democrat. She died in 1903; her sons owned the Democrat until 1920.

CIVIC ISSUES INSPIRED SERVICE, POTENT PEN

When something was on Jim Lee Morgan's mind, he never hesitated to pick up a pen and let the editor of the newspaper know all about it.

His frequent missives were sprinkled with exclamation points when he got his dander up about topics as diverse as where the Razorbacks should play - "I would like the people of Little Rock to urge UALR to develop a football program and to fill the coliseum in the future!" -to the vagaries of the IRS---"I can testify to both the lack of good computer use and the insouciance of the IRS in dealing with both their masters (we the public) and their managers (our elected leaders)."

The blunt, lucid language was typical of a man who had moved easily between the academic, political and military arenas during a life that took him to military bases in Germany, stars' homes in Beverly Hills and back again to Little Rock.

Morgan died Monday at the age of 57. He suffered from peripheral neuropathy, his father said, which eventually confined him to a walker and made it difficult for him to live alone. But Morgan's medical troubles didn't affect his intensity or his competitive streak, his father said.

"We must have played 1,000 games of gin rummy," James C. Morgan said of his son. "And the last eight games we played, he won six of them. Which is unusual - even he said so - because I'll bet you there is usually not ten games difference between the games we have won and lost."

As a child, Morgan was a formidable contender. Although his eye-sight in one eye was terrible, forcing him to wear bifocals at the age of 12, he still hit 18 home runs in the 18 games played by his Amarillo, Texas, softball team.

The child of military parents and himself a future Air Force Captain, Morgan moved around for



much of his early life, attending five different German schools during the first grade. Eventually, he landed at the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville, his father's old stomping grounds. There he served as vice president of the student senate, rubbing elbows with well-known Arkansas political figures like Thomas F. "Mack" McLarty, former chief of staff for President Clinton, and former Gov. Jim Guy Tucker. After college, it was Los Angeles - not Washington, D.C., or Little Rock - where Morgan landed. As executive assistant to the mayor of Beverly Hills, he toiled on the same kinds of problems that mayor's offices everywhere deal with - sewer hookups, garbage collection, persuading voters to approve city-issued bonds.

During his California years, Morgan was something of a civic activist, his father said, serving on a committee that advised then Gov. Jerry Brown about the future of the state's university system, teaching courses on business law and economics and working to establish a senior citizens center in Simi Valley.

He stopped only when his health gave out. His father drove halfway across the country to bring Morgan back to Little Rock. Home again, he volunteered with hospice care, counseling people close to death, but his own health was failing and though his apartment was equipped with banisters and hand-holds, he had to live at times at home with his family.

"This guy was sharp," his father said. "He was somebody who could pull people together. He was very intense in his work - whatever he was doing, that's what he was focused on."
