John Newcomer served as Justice of the Peace, 1918-1920, and as Mount Morris Township Clerk, 1928-1930. He had a farm northeast of Milledgeville, Illinois from 1937 to 1941.

John Newcomer, Sr. died in the evening at a bowling alley in Polo, Illinois. He was bowling with a neighbor, Ed Vock, when he suffered a heart attack and died. Esther Newcomer, his wife, was working as a nurse at the Dixon State Hospital that evening. Burns Newcomer, his youngest son, was home at the farm several miles north of Hitt. It was a Saturday night and the farmers and city folks were in town for shopping and movies. It had

been snowing and there were three or four inches of snow on the streets. Someone called the movies at Dixon, Illinois and an announcement was made over the speakers for John Newcomer, Jr., the oldest son, to come to the box office, where he was informed of his father's heart attack.

Ethelene Clingenpeel, later to become Burns Newcomer's wife, happened to be bowling in another alley at the time John Newcomer, Sr. died.

In 1866 he joined the Church of the Brethren. He was elected to the ministry of the Church of the Brethren in 1869.

Melchor Newcomer's book of poems and prose entitled "Golden Gleamings, Comprising Poems and Prose Extracts from the Writings of M. S. Newcomer" was published by the Daily Republican Printing and Binding House in Cedar Rapids, Iowa in 1891.

Cornelius Clingenpeel was known as "Neal" to most, and C. J. to many. To me, as a child, he was great granddad with the feathers--his pure white hair and big mustache reminded my preadolescent mind of bird feathers.

Cornelius Clingenpeel earned a teaching certificate from the Duncan School. The school was also known as the Hales Ford Classical and Mathematical Academy at Scruggs. He taught at Mountain View School and other area schools.

In 1896 he became a merchant for C. L. Saul and Company postmaster of Toccoa, Virginia. In 1898 he bought C. L. Saul and Company. One year later he sold the company to T. L. Saul.

Cornelius and his wife began farming on land next to Bush Run in 1899. On 16 March 1900, the land was partially given to them and partially sold to them by Cora's father, Joel Flora. C. J. and Cora began with one milk cow, a calf, one dozen chickens and a bay mare.

He was a trustee of the Antioch Church of the Brethren.

Sandra Williams reported that Cornelius Clingenpeel's birth day was the 1 st, although the family Bible listed the 10th. I have used the family Bible day.
