Rev. Thomas M. Strange was born in Raglesville, Ind, June 28, 1851 and came to the end of his earthly pilgrimage Sunday October 19, 1919, at 6 p.m. He came with his parent to Kansas in the spring of 1866.

They stopped near Bennington, Kansas, during the summer, then in the fall they were joined by Wm.

Hendrickson and family when they all moved to Lincoln Co., Kansas. Here he grew to manhood and was

married to Miss Sarah Ann Bird on August 15, 1871. To this union was born 15 children, five of these, with his first companion, have passed to the Great Beyond. He joined the militia June 6, 1869, and was mustered in

July 12, 1869, serving until Dec 1, 1869. when he was relieved from duty. He was converted to the Christian faith in 1876. He soon heard the Master call to the ministry and in 1883 he was ordained as a Gospel Minister by the Kansas Christian Conference. During his ministry he served 15 Churches, besides Holding many successful evangelistic meetings. He preached the Gospel in 4 states Kansas, Nebraska, Arkansas and Oklahoma. He was a loyal man to his church, having preached for nearly nothing when splendid offers from other sources were offered. The First Christian Church has lost a good and valuable friend, and supporter. He leaves to mourn his departure, wife, ten children, Ed. Strange of Barnard, Ks, Laura and Mary Oliver Strange, Lincoln, Ks, Thomas Strange and Della Sharp; Francis Barr, Oberlin Ks; Raches Hanshaw, Shelby Neb.; Nellie Robinson, Oklahoma; Phoebe Lindermuth Springfield, Mo..
