Also according to tradition, Anne died in 1832 or 1833. Matthew died in 1839 and they both are buried on their farm in Woodstock, New York. At his death the Village bell tolled 99 times.

Among the first settlers of Keelersburg were John and Mary Lawson Dymond about 1800, and that they moved to Sickler's Hill, and finally resided on a 150 acre virgin farm at Lockville which is today known as Diamond Hollow, PA. Lockville took its first name from the locks on the nearby uncompleted Susquehanna Canal. The Dymond Hollow Methodist church and cemetery are well preserved and cared for, but the other buildings such as the post office, the general store, the furniture factory and the family homesteads are either in a state of decay or have disappeared. The mill and millpond are gone and there is only slight evidence of the millrace. There are still a few Dymond names on a mailbox here and there....The first Methodist Church building was erected in 1835. The present church was built in 1870. Dymond Hollow is off the beaten path and only a narrow winding dirt road with a few dilapidated buildings remain.

You might try to contact the Library for more information. It has been years since I was there and they keep getting information from people who search for their family lines. If you do find out any thing I would greatly appreciate any new news. Thank you and good luck.

I am sure we are talking about same individuals . I have news paper article that says she was 6 years old when the Declaration of Independence was signed. She is a hard lady to find before she married John B. Dymond. She is of Indian decent. I went to Poughkeepsie NY and found that there was some Indians with the Name of Lo Song And that was misspelled to Lawson. I even found a wedding in which that name was used. Mary Dymond, a widow lady, resident of this county, was born in Poughkeepsie, NY in 1771. At an early age she was married to the late John Dymond, at that place. They continued to reside there for many years and where they had five children born, Matthew, Joseph, Mariah, Anna and Abram. In 1816 she accompanied her husband and children into this, then howling wilderness, and lived for a short time in a rude hut at Osterhout's. In 1817 removed to Keeler's and in 1817 moved on the farm in Exeter Twp., where her husband died a few years since at the age of 84 years, and where she still resides with her son, Isaac. At this place they had six children born, John, Mabel, William, Jane, Isaac, and Mahala. Of the whole number only five are now living. This old Lady is remarkably smart for one her age. She is of the medium height, her form slender and slightly bent forward. In appearance she has a very old look, eyes and hair black and face very much wrinkled. Her history includes the interval of the past 100 years. The scenes, hardships and sufferings of the past years of a century it has been her lot to witness and endure. A life lengthened out, has been passed over, and yet she still lives the same Christian's life that she has ever lived. For many years she and her husband were worthy members of the M.E. Church having full faith that Jesus Christ is the Son of the only living and one true God, who came to redeem the world
