GEORGE SHAPPCOTT:

Baptism, marriage and burial registration by the Established Church began in 1538, but it was 60 years before proper books became obligatory and few records that old are still in existence. Cruwys Morchard registers date from 1572; George is the first mention of the surname.

However, it is Thomas, probably born earlier in Knowstone, who is most likely to be our ancestor.

The 16th and 17th centuries research is bedevilled by the lack of, or even the destruction of data during the interregnum; there are very tenuous links for the next four generations!

THOMAS SHAPCOTT:

A very shadowy character; he consistently appears in the Cruwys Morchard records as the father of the four children, but no mention of his own birth or marriage. There is a note in the marriage register dating from just after the Restoration to

the effect that entries for 1621 to 1629 were lost but his marriage in 1626 (but without an exact date) popped up in some extremely obscure Bishop Transcripts data from another researcher.

Thomas was the only Shapcott mentioned in Cruwys Morchard to sign the Protestation in 1642 ("all males over 18").

Other: From Lt. Col. J. S. Vivian's 1887 transcript of "The Bishop of Exeter's Registers"; there is a John Beedle in the Cruwys Morchard Protestation.

A famous contemporary of Thomas was Col. Robert Shapcott, a Regimental commander in Cromwell's army during the Civil War, whose men garrisoned in Exeter after the city fell to General Fairfax in April 1646. Born in Bradninch, Devon, in 1620, he was a second cousin to Thomas, being a great-grandson of the original John Shepcott through the second marriage of John's son Philip.

A study of the IGI for Devon shows that, in the early 16th century, the name, seemingly centered in Cruwys Morchard, had spread north to the edge of Exmoor and south to Exeter. The rich branch of the family (dating from a 15th century union between a Shapcott and an heiress named Windegate) was already well established in Knowstone.

THOMAS SHAPCOTT:

The marriage of Thomas and Alyce would have taken place during the Puritan Repression. Later, from 1653 until the Restoration, in 1660, marriage ceremonies had to be performed by a representative of the civil authority; during this period,

many churches were desecrated and their registers destroyed. Many clergy, at great personal risk, secretly copied their records and kept them up-to-date, which is why, even if the details of Thomas and Alyce's marriage are lost, the baptism records of their children are still around, three and a half centuries later.

JONE "CHUGGEY" CLOGGE:

The name "CHUGGEY" is most odd--Jone (sic) is the only one listed in the IGI (amongst the Cheggeys), appearing to have come from nowhere. However, there are several "Clogg(e)s" in Cruwys Morchard, and John Shipcott is convinced that in spite of the undoubted clarity of the register entry (which could well have been copies from scribbled--perhaps illegible--notes made earlier), that she was really a "Clogge", of which there are several in the area. It is on this assumption that John Shipcott has entered details of antecedents and other relations. (There are Cloggs in the adjacent parish of Cheriton Fitzpaine, but not for this period).

The identity of George Shapcot's wife caused John Grant Shipcott, and probably other researchers, a great deal of anguish. The record of the 1700 marriage in the Cruwys Morchard register, in extravagantly beautiful copperplate handwriting and does not allow the slightest possibility of misinterpretation and is accepted unquestioningly by the compilers of the IGI and, apparently by other researchers, Betty Shapcott of Seaton, Jenny Shapcott of Dartford and Rev. Leonard Shapcott in New Zealand. The trouble was that when John started to look for our ancestors in the early 1900s, he came up against a brick wall, with no trace of "Jone" or of anyone who might be her kin.

However, John frequently found evidence that made him suspicious even of original records. The mutual consistency of many register entries indicated to John that they could well have been all written up at the same time, perhaps days or weeks afterwards, working from scribbled, possibly illegible notes on the back of a medieval envelope; add to this a parson who probably cared little about his peasant "flock" and you have a major source of error.

Casting around for an alternative, John discovered CLOGG(E)S and he now has little doubt that "Jone" was one of them; the family was established in Cruwys Morchard and several adjacent parishes and her grandfather was probably the Thomas who signed the Protestation.

MARGARET WOODS:

Margaret's surname is not clear in the register; the IGI, copying DCRS index, goes for "Weeks" but in the original, it is surely "oo" in the middle; John's initial reading of it was "Wooler" but he came to the conviction that it is "WOODS". Although he has yet to find any likely candidates, a Mary WOOD was married three months earlier. The pre-1739

Brampford Speke registers were lost in the 1750s and there are no leads in Thorveton records or in the IGI.

The change to SHIPCOTT began around this time, first occurring in the baptism entry of Robert's third child at Thorveton. Margaret's burial record also uses the modern spelling.

JOHN SHIPCOT:

John's surname at birth "Shapcot" was later changed to "Shipcot" due to the "Dempshire" accent and later evolved to "Shipcott". The surname "Shapcott" appeared in the marriage registry. John and Bridget may have had other children, the names and sex of whom are unknown.

Slightly tenuous data about John's origins -- this is the (much) more likely of two at the time Shapcott was becoming Shipcott and both versions of the name were in use. The marriage entry seems to be the last appearance of "Shapcott" in this line.

There is no real evidence to support the death date which is from the St. Mary Steps register; however, he doesn't figure among the Brampford Speke burial -- nor is there any mention of further children born to him in the village -- and the younger daughter was in Exeter when she died in 1808.

BRIDGET MARIA JARMAN:

Little known about Bridget (Maria) Jarman, except that she was in service (and illiterate!). There seems to be some confusion about her Christian names -- it is likely that, although christened Bridget, she was, at a time when domestic servants were only slightly better than slaves, perhaps 'given' a more 'suitable' name by her employer.

John says that a search of the burial registers for Thorveton (up to 1837), New St Cyres and Brampford Speke has failed to turn up any details about her death, but it might be worth checking St Mary Steps.

JOHN SHIPCOTT:

He was noted in the marriage register as "carpenter" and uprated to "Joiner" on his second son's marriage certificate many years later. As the son of two illiterates, marrying a member of a leading local family, he did pretty well for himself! He was also the first in the line to use the modern spelling of the name "Shipcott" consistently--perhaps because he was the first one able to write.

PHENICE SLADE:

One of John's favorite ancestors, perhaps because of the exotic name.

Six weeks after Phenice's birth, a brigantine, en route from Sr. Petersburg to Genoa with a cargo of Russian reindeer leather, sank in Plymouth Sound. John has a keyfob made of that leather.

It was November, 1986 before John laid his favorite ancestor to rest; something like twelve years since first discovering her and struggling to make sense of her name.

In 1986, all of our English cousins attended "Phenice 200", a weekend party to celebrate her birthday, so her name is now rooted in Shipcott folklore. (There are several other Phenices including John's granddaughter, a very special bearer of the name after a gap of two generations).

More than 12 years after John discovered Phenice, he formed a (perhaps over-romantic) picture of her, including that she "married beneath herself". Her husband, John, being a "simple carpenter", while, for instance, her younger sister was the village school-mistress.

After learning that Phenice was widowed when she was only 31, with three small children, John Grant Shipcott wanted very much to find out what happened to her. A woman in that position didn't have much choice--professional housekeeper, remarriage or parish relief was about all.

John learned that Phenice's children (well, the sons anyway), still under sixteen, stayed in Shobrooke with the Shipcott name. Phenice and her new husband moved back to "his" village.

Phenice's second marriage was found through the Devon Family History Society's marriage index and thus opened up a new avenue of research. Her second husband was a Cornish farmer, William Couls, who she married in the small market town of Harberton, Devon on Oct 5, 1825. They then lived in Williams's home village of South Petherwin, near Launceston in Cornwall. (That's officially pronounced Lawns-ton, but a true Cornishman will call it Lance-un!). There were no child born of this marriage.

Phenice died on 22 Sep 1840, probably an extremely painful death, due to blockage of the esophagus. Her probably lingering and painful death was, a professional suggested, probably caused by a peptic ulcer which eventually blocked off the entry to the stomach.

William followed her in death on 6 Feb 1841, in theory due to kidney failure, but being a romantic, I like to think it was a broken heart. They are buried together in South Petherwin churchyard, Devon. Their joint gravestone is as clear today as the day it was carved. The story about its discovery appeared in the Parish Magazine in early 1997 by John Grant Shipcott.

MARY SHIPCOTT:

There were TWO William and Mary Radfords in Silverton with numerous children between them, but a study of the 1851 census sorted them out. However, although Mary gives her birthplace as "Exeter" -- just about acceptable -- her stated age is well adrift from the Shobrooke baptism record (and the Silverton burial record is inconsistent with both!) and John has come round to the view that the Mary Shipcott whose marriage and death details are listed in this entry was not great-grandfather's sister at all, but the daughter of William and Sarah Shipcott, born in Broadclyst (9 Aug 1812) and connected with the Whitestone branch of the family.

JOHN SHIPCOTT:

It is interesting to compare the lives of the two (surviving) brothers. John lived in the city (Cowick St, St Thomas, Exeter) where, in the 1840s, Elizabeth and two children died, probably from smallpox or cholera or some such horror, while William and Sophia lived in a village, surrounded, as I imagine it, by hoards of healthy offspring. In the 1851 census, John (now widowed) was living at Cottage Hermitage", Exwick and was chapel clerk there.

(According to the 1851 Religious Census, Exwick chapel was Wesleyan Methodist and in a building "not exclusively used for...worship" - i.e., in someone's parlour).

WILLIAM SHIPCOTT:

William Shipcott was our commonly shared great-grandfather with John Grant Shipcott (our English cousin).

William Shipcott was born in the village of Shobrooke, near Exeter, Devon, on December 25, 1811, to John Shipcott and Phenice (nee Slade), the second of their four children. When he was six, his father died and, eight years later, his mother was re-married to a man named COULS. He was only 13 when his mother remarried; surprisingly, he didn't take her new name. Had he done so, we'd all today be Couls! It is one of the minor mysteries of our research that neither William nor his elder brother, John, took their step-father's name.

Some time in the 1820s and 1830s, William learned to become a wheelwright - a skilled and respected trade, which required a quite long apprenticeship. William's name (mis-spelled) appears in several trade directories as the Shobrooke village wheelwright, a skilled and respected trade. It is possible that he served his apprenticeship at Dunsford.

In 1834, William married Sophia Paddon in the nearby village of Dunsford (where she was probably working as a live-in domestic servant) before settling in Holcombe Burnell, the village of her birth, and setting up business.

Five months after they were wed, William's son, John, arrived. (Going off on a tangent for a moment - this was a pretty common occurrence, especially in rural communities where the view, originating in medieval times, was still held that marriage was primarily for the production of children to help support one, especially in old-age, and that therefore a couple planning marriage had to make sure that the union would be fruitful before they took what was then an irreversible step). Further children arrived with the normal frequency - William (1836), Phenice (1838), George (1840), James (1842), Anne (1844), Robert P. (1847), Henry (1850) and Charles (1852).

(Two of Robert's three granddaughters, born 1921 and 1928 and never married, still live in the city of Bristol).

In 1851, William was appointed as enumerator for the village during the ten-yearly national census and his signature appears on the returns. It is fascinating to note that this signature is virtually identical to those on the marriage records of his father, his son, and his grandson, Reginald John Shipcott, born 1899. His house listed in 1851 (it was empty in 1861) still stands, next-door-but-two to the Lamb Inn at Longdowns on the Exeter, Moreton Hampstead road.

When "William Bradford" was conceived, his mother, Sarah Salter Bell Gibbs Bradford, had been widowed for three years. His birth had been registered giving a fictitious name for the father. The boy's baptism record did not show a father at all! His birthname was "William Bradford". He was actually the illegitimate son of William Shipcott and Sarah Salter Bell Gibbs Bradford. After the death of William Shipcott's first wife, Sophia Paddon, William Shipcott married Sarah, on 2 Feb 1868, and he adopted his natural born son, "William Bradford", who would henceforth be known as "William Bradford Shipcott".

William and Sarah lived on Mint Street, Exeter/St Olaves, which is in the oldest part of Exeter (there was presumably a mint there once, probably when the city was under siege during the Civil War) and is nowadays more realistically known as Mint Lane, being literally about 6' wide, but in the 19th century it was popularly known just as 'The Mint' and this is the address which William and Sarah give in the 1871 census. Lastly, there is the 1881 census entry in which the family had moved to a rather better address in Goldsmith Street (an area destroyed in the blitz). William, Sr. still claims to be a wheelwright and William Bradford Shipcott, now 18, has been put down as 'servant' with the word 'wheel' inserted as an afterthought so he was presumably "Helping The Old Man".

It is still not known why William died in Bideford (or what "The Grange" was). Report of the inquest the next day contained no helpful detail.

Family tradition states that William's son, William Bradford Shipcott, moved to and later married in Ireland. (See notes for William Bradford Shipcott).

SOPHIA PADDON:

Sophia died sometime in the 1860's. John suspects that it was in the latter part of the decade, since it seems that, when this happened, the youngest child was probably old enough to be independent. Her "occupation" (domestic servant) is based on the assumption that, being so young and living in the next parish to the rest of her family, she was unlikely to be anything except a "live-in domestic".

SARAH BELL GIBBS SALTER:

This lady, once only known as a Christian name as a result of her appearance in the 1871 census, later assumed importance as the natural mother of "William Bradford Shipcott", who was the founder of a whole new Shipcott dynasty in the USA. Sarah was the illegitimate daughter of another Sarah Salter. A few months after she was born, her mother married James Bell, a mariner, Sarah's natural father. About 1830, the family settled in the little Devon port of Topsham. Her parents had at least eight other children; these children were born between 1831 and 1844, and all of them, including Sarah, used the surname of "Bell". Although Sarah used the name "Bell" as a child, she apparently discarded it in adulthood. She was listed as "Sarah Bell" on her second marriage record. She was described on her son's birth certificate as "late Salter". The Clyst St George Bishops' Transcripts (the registers were destroyed in 1940) showed her birth as illegitimate, but with James Bell admitting paternity; she used the Bell name as a schoolgirl, but Salter reappears in later times.

SARAH SALTER was born in the hamlet of Clyst St George, a few miles from Exeter in about 1823, the illegitimate daughter of another Sarah Salter. Trying to find her origins was complicated by the fact that the parish records were destroyed during a major air-raid on Exeter in 1941, but there are many other traces of her. A few months after the birth, the mother married James BELL, a mariner; initially, they made their home in Clyst St George but, in about 1830, they settled in the little Devon port of Topsham. Her mother and step-father had eight children of their own (of whom five can be found in the International Genealogical Index (IGI) during the period 1831-1844 and all of them, including Sarah herself (using her step-father's name), can be found in the records of Topsham school (photocopying not allowed). It was later learned and confirmed that James BELL was Sarah's natural father, and admitted paternity. Inasmuch as he was a sailor in the Newfoundland trade, it is very likely that he was away at sea at the time of her birth, and was unable to marry the mother until his return.

In adulthood, Sarah apparently avoided her father's name whenever possible (her marriage certificate has a blank where it should go); one must assume she didn't get on with him.

Topsham was where James Bell and Sarah Salter, Sr. lived and where their children grew up, including Sarah (Jr.) Salter Gibbs. Topsham was Exeter's port from 13th to 16th century (after which a canal was constructed around a blockage in the river) and later a busy fishing port (the fishing fleet is long gone - there are just pleasure boats now).

Census searches. TOPSHAM

CLYST ST GEORGE -- In Clyst St George, where Sarah Salter Bell Gibbs was born, the ancient church was reduced to a bare shell filled with rubble as the result of a single incendiary bomb in 1940. The registers were destroyed because the priest was too stubborn to deposit these priceless mediaeval records in the local authority's fireproof and air-conditioned strong room.

John Grant Shipcott, through much searching, located the Bishop's Transcripts for Clyst St George, (only chunks of them are still available - several grubby bundles of dirty manuscript, many with folds never flattened since they were made nearly 200 years ago). Most of the records were destroyed during the war in 1941. John was advised that if he intended delving into them to take a supply of baby-wipes - good advice, as it turned out! He managed to look through the set covering the period about 1820 to 1850, and found an entry confirming that Sarah, mother of William Bradford Shipcott,

was born out of wedlock (baptized December 14, 1823) and given the full name of Sarah Bell Gibbs Salter (Gibbs - a local family, perhaps the grandmother's maiden name) but the record also showed that James Bell - who later married the mother - accepted paternity - so, although the child's illegitimacy might have upset the faint-hearted, it wasn't quite so bad as John first assumed!

EXETER - Exeter itself, the site of a settlement since the 2nd or 3rd centuries BC, now a pleasant modern city, but with numerous reminders of its past.

Sarah, Jr.'s, first appearance in the context of this subject is in the city of Exeter (St Sidwell parish) when, as Sarah BRADFORD, she and her husband, John Bradford, had a son, named William Bradford, in August 1862.

Prior to the time of Sarah's son, William Bradford's, birth, John Bradford died - or at any rate disappeared from the scene - and in February 1868, she married William SHIPCOTT at St Olave's Church in Exeter; part of the arrangement must have been that he 'adopt' her five-year-old son, who would henceforth be known as WILLIAM BRADFORD SHIPCOTT.

John Grant Shipcott had the opportunity to review the 1861 census records and found Sarah Salter Bell Bradford listed as a widow at that time. She had two children living with her at that time, to wit: Elizabeth, age 9, and Margaret, age 8. She was living at Lions' Holt. Therefore, her son William Bradford, born in 1862, was not the son of her deceased husband, John Bradford. In fact, he was the son of William Shipcott, to whom she was later married. William Shipcott "adopted" his own natural born son.

The word 'adopted' is in quotation marks because legal adoption as we know it today was not established in Great Britain until surprisingly recently - 1927, in fact. Before that, it was all quite informal and census returns do not necessarily show such a relationship, although an adopted child may sometimes appear as 'son/daughter-in-law'. The Shipcott family appears in both the 1871 and 1881 census returns for Exeter with young William shown simply as 'son'.

It had been the routine for generations (and remained so until past the turn of the century) for most families to churn out children every year or so - with every third or fourth one dying in infancy - until the mother reached her early forties or died of sheer exhaustion; within this system, how is it that Sarah brought to her marriage with William Shipcott only a five-year-old child? Why not also a seven-year-old and an eight-year-old and a ten-year-old? Of course, if she didn't marry until about 1860, and then was widowed soon after young William was born, that would explain it, but delaying marriage until she was in her late thirties would be very unusual.

I feel I must comment about the discovery that great-grandma Sarah was born Out Of Wedlock and any upset that this may have caused but I have seen it suggested that anyone who hasn't got any illegitimacy in their family tree has simply covered it up! (Was it Andy Warhol who reckoned that sex was invented in 1960? He was dead wrong). A well-respected member of the Devon Family History Society swears that she overheard an American lady in the Devon Records Office say "Oh look, Elmer, here's one that was 'baseborn' - he can't be one of ours". Oh yes he can.

Sarah died of cardiac disease, dropsy. William was present at her death. Her death was certified by a Dr. Charles Bell; not a relative; he was born in Exeter in 1834, son of an Irish priest. There is also no tie-up with Elizabeth Salter.

He had something! After three years as a widower, he married a "domestic" many years his junior and kept her in a constant state of pregnancy until he was nearly seventy--and still outlived her. He lived at 8, West Street until his death (Elsie stayed on with her family until about 1932). Recently demolished (and the remaining houses then renumbered), the site was (just!) big enough for a South-West Electricity Board sub-station. The 1891 census (listing him, Susan and Percy) also listed Maud Avery, 3, "niece"--a fictitious relationship, John suspects for a child being sheltered from an overcrowding charge.

At age sixteen, John was living with his grandmother Paddon on her farm at Dunsford, but sometime in the 1850s, he and his brother James got live-in jobs at the Poltimore Hotel in St. Sidwell Street, Exeter, and it was here that he met Elizabeth. She was some years older than him and already had an illegitimate son, Thomas Henry, born about 1857, probably fathered by her employer when she was "in service" in the small town of Chudleigh. They were married in 1861 in a civil ceremony at Exeter Register Office and rented a house in West Street. John flitted from one unskilled job to another ("Boots at a Hotel"; Porter; Packer; Dairyman; Insurance Agent; and eventually with the "Pru" (Prudential Insurance Co.

John married Susan Ireland, in 1884, but that was his second try. His first wife, Elizabeth Salter, born 1828, and died 1881, by whom he had six children, was some years older than him and had brought to their marriage in 1861, a five-year-old illegitimate son whom John adopted as his own.

ELIZABETH SALTER (John Shipcott's first wife):

Elizabeth was the illegitimate child of Anne Salter. (Incidentally, Ann's sister, Fanny, had TWO illegitimate off-spring, in spite of calling herself "Frances". The record of Elizabeth's marriage at Exeter Register Office in 1861 details a father, Richard Salter. John is certain that this was a fiction; having a five-year-old son was bad enough without having to admit her own illegitimacy!

Elizabeth's existence was only discovered because of a chance remark by Aunt Elsie. John Grant Shipcott had to get one of the children's birth certificates to find her maiden name. For years, he had no success looking for the marriage in Down St Mary and Exeter or the St Cats indexes -- not surprising since:

- (a) it was, going by the age of the eldest child, six years after it "should be", and
- (b) it wasn't in a church at all.

Further, for the purpose of the marriage (unless John Grant Shipcott has something horribly wrong!), she not only took three years off her age (two of which were put back when she died), but also invented a father. On the marriage certificate of Elizabeth and John Shipcott, Elizabeth claimed that her father was the late Richard Salter; John reckons that this was a piece of fiction in the cause of social decorum.

The 1891 census lists her as "shop keeper (dairy)"; it also shows a 3-year-old "niece", Maud B. Avery; her family is in Ide, but don't seem to be related and John suspects that the child was just being sheltered.

Cecil was the twin brother of Leonard. He was one of nature's perfect gentlemen; when John's mother was widowed he offered to marry her, considering it to be his Christian duty. Completely without ambition, he worked for most of his life in the carpet department of an Exeter store, devoting most of his spare time to the church. He was a warden at St Mary's Steps, a church which played a major part in the more recent family history, and his name is one of those incorporated into the mediaeval church clock when it was rebuilt just before his death.

It was only in 1983 that John discovered from his Aunt Elsie that Cecil was one of twins, and that he had been gassed during the Great War. He was the twin brother of Leonard.

Extremely incomprehensible! Charlotte and her three siblings were all baptized on the same day; there is no indication in the register as to whether it was a mass ceremony or they were quadruplets -- although Charlotte's age in the censuses confirms her birth about that time. None of the five Turner references in the 1851 census index for Crediton is her family, so that's no help! Crediton was a small market town about 20 miles from Exeter.

While still single, Charlotte acted as witness at the second marriage of William Shipcott, father of her husband-to-be, in Exeter, in 1868. She was present at her son Albert's wedding in 1912.

WILLIAM BRADFORD SHIPCOTT:

William was born 14 Aug 1862, at St Sidwell, Exeter ("Lions Holt"--should be "Lions Halt", the former name of St James Great West Railway Station.

When "William Bradford" was conceived, his mother, Sarah Salter Bell Gibbs Bradford, had been widowed for three years. His birth had been registered giving a fictitious name for the father. The boy's baptism record did not show a father at all! His birthname was "William Bradford". He was actually the illegitimate son of William Shipcott and Sarah Salter Bell Gibbs Bradford. After the death of William Shipcott's first wife, Sophia Paddon, William Shipcott married Sarah, on 2 Feb 1868, and he adopted his natural born son, "William Bradford", who would henceforth be known as "William Bradford Shipcott".

In 1881, William was still in Exeter, working for his father (William Shipcott). Sometime between 1882 and 1886, he went to Ireland.

Upon settling in Belfast, Ireland, he obtained a job at a Dry Soup Factory. He married his boss's daughter, Annie Cean/Cain/Kane or O'Kane), on 27 March 1886, at Belfast, Parish of Mariners, Ireland. (Her name first appeared as "Cean"). She would have pronounced her name as "key-ann" and that the register entry of "Cean" was probably how this was interpreted, because of an extremely thick Belfast accent, by an English Registrar who did not get it right. After all, Cain or O'Kane are common enough Irish names -- you'd have thought he should have known better!

William eventually became Manager of the Soup Factory. This union produced a daughter, Annie Ethel Shipcott, born in 1887. Apparently, Annie died and William raised said child. Said child lived with William and his second wife, Elizabeth McMillan, as shown by the censuses of 1901 and 1911.

A witness at William's marriage to Elizabeth (and the groom in the next marriage register entry!) was Henry Hanna, after whom he named his second son. Henry Hanna married Elizabeth's sister, Sarah Lyttle McMillan, the same day.

Having become established in Ireland, William did better for himself than his contemporaries, progressing from tinsmith and iron casemaker to factory manager (Edwards Dessicated Soups) by 1909. The various addresses on the census records also show an increasingly better standard of living although his arithmetic didn't look too good; he must have spent a lot of time hiding from his wife, the fact that he was over ten years older than her, losing two years in the censuses (and, oddly, two more on his death certificate).

William died in the Royal Victoria Hospital, Belfast, Ireland from injuries he sustained after being run over by a bus (see newspaper articles from "The Belfast Evening Telegraph"). His pelvis was fractured and his bladder had ruptured. The accident occurred while he was on manoeuvres with a "Loyalist" militia unit. He was a member of the "Earl of Roden's Total Abstinence L.O.L. 246", in Belfast, Ireland, up to the time of his death. The following is quoted from the Belfast Evening Telegraph newspaper, Wednesday, October 28, 1914: "Funeral of Mr. W. B. Shipcott--"The funeral of the late Mr. William B. Shipcott, of 2 Lockview Road, Stranmillis Road, who was killed under tragic circumstances on Saturday on the Upper Malone Road, took place on Tuesday to the City Cemetery. A very impressive service was conducted at the house by Rev. Chas. Davey, Fisherwick, and the cortege was both large and representative. The Ulster Volunteer Force, of which deceased was a popular member, was well represented. On behalf of the South Belfast Regiment, Mr. R. J. Calwell, Regimental Commander, was present, while the 5th Battalion was represented by Battalion Commander C. J. Brenan and Adjutant J. J. Hyde. There were many score of the rank and file. These were followed by members of the "Orange Order" and the Independent Order of Rechabites. A number of beautiful wreaths sent by sorrowing friends testified to the regard with which deceased was held. At the graveside, the service was conducted by Rev. Charles Davey and Rev. Mr. Thompson."

Several years after William's death, his widow, Elizabeth, took the surviving children to Toronto, Canada and then eventually the USA, where the elder son, William Bradford Shipcott, started a whole new dynasty now spread all over California.

ELIZABETH McMILLAN:

After the deaths of her husband and two daughters (Beatrice and Eleanor), Elizabeth left Ireland (about 1920) and went to Toronto, Canada. They loved it there. They were admired in Toronto for the way they dressed and looked like "high class" people from England. The weather became very cold and Mable took ill and died of pneumonia in 1923. Elizabeth then took her only two surviving children: William and Henry ("Harry"), and moved to Los Angeles, California. She obtained a job as a salesclerk in the Christian Book Store at Biola Bible Institute and College, Los Angeles, California. Both boys attended college there. Her sons had good singing voices, and they joined the Mens' Quartet and choirs. William was the "high tenor" in the Mens' Quartet. They travelled up and down the coast of California performing with the Mens' Quartet and Mens' Choirs.

Elizabeth married a gentlemen by the name of Schram (or similar) in Los Angeles, California, sometime during the 1930s. He died of a heart attack in the late 1940s or early 1950s. Her son, Henry ("Harry") was killed in WWII, while on his way to Japan. He was aboard a destroyer ship when it was attacked by Japanese suicide planes. The ship caught fire and they had to abandon ship. He was lost at sea in 1944.

Her son William died in Obrero Hospital, Ave. Buenos Aires, Piura, Peru, South America, at age 50, on September 8, 1955. The cause of death was "cirrhosis of the liver, and hemorrhage from rupture of esophageal varix", following a surgical operation. He slipped and fell while boarding his ship and sustained severe injuries.

Elizabeth, being the only survivor of her family, returned to Ireland about 1956 to live out her remaining years with her sister, who lived in Dublin. She died in Dublin about 1959 or 1960. Her grandson, Stanley Earl Shipcott, went to visit her in Ireland, but learned that she had died just two weeks before he arrived. He was in the U. S. Army, stationed first in Germany, then in London, England, and had arranged leave to go to Ireland at that time. He met his Irish relatives and was very warmly received.

PERCIVAL "PERCY" SHIPCOTT:

A regular soldier from about 1906, Percy survived the Great War and was posted to the Chester Garrison--hence his having his home there. John's parents visited the family in 1947, so they must have kept in touch after his death. John visited them shortly after (during John's RAF training), at 15, Crane St., Chester; there was a comfortably large elderly aunt and three delightfully old-fashioned (still unmarried) cousins, but when John went again in about 1961, the street had gone. A former neighbor telephoned John (after an appeal on Teletext, March 1993) and said that Percy was still alive in 1939 and Ernest in 1972. John kept digging and eventually found Ernest only a few months before he died, living in sheltered accommodation in Exeter. Now well into his eighties, he was able to supply a few details about his family, but had become greatly confused about much of his life.

Percy was a gambler and a heavy drinker, his comparatively early death being virtually self-induced; his younger son, Leslie, took after him, dying in his early fifties. The daughter (Alison Gladys Florence, known as Gladys) also died in her fifties, of cancer. She never married; both sons did, however, but fairly late in life.

Ernest was educated at various army schools (Aldershot, Catterick). A disastrous marriage ended in separation after twenty years and he moved back to Exeter. After his death in 1997, his death, his marriage certificate and his father's death certificate surfaced, giving valuable information.

When, in late October 1997, John Grant Shipcott finally tracked down Ernest, the sole survivor of his family, Ernest was 85 and in very poor health (he died a few weeks later). He was quite unable to be specific, but John deduced that Ernest's wife, Lillian Mary Ewings, turned out to be an absolute hell-cat; after they separated, Ernest moved to Exeter because his mother (born Shillingford about 1885, died at age 76) had spoken so fondly of the city. Doris was always known as "Gus"--to everyone except her parents. She lived at various addresses in Coventry; left school at 14, worked in a city jeweler's shop until her marriage to John's father. They eventually set up a home at 47, Leys Avenue, Cambridge. After being widowed in 1948, she got a job at the Ministry of Agriculture's low-temperature research establishment at Downing College, where the staff appreciated being "mothered" by her; to them, for some reason, she was always "Ingrid".

Doris' second marriage (encouraged by John and Joan!). She continued her job at the MAFF laboratory until retirement in 1962; deciding that a "semi" was getting too much, she and Sid moved to a mobile home at Great Shelford, south of Cambridge in 1974. After being widowed again in 1978, she began to crack up and was moved, by Joyce and John, to an

old people's home near St. Ives, Cornwall. She eventually died in the hospital in Truro; cremated at Penmount, and her ashes returned to Cambridge where they were scattered in the Crematorium garden. Subsequently, John had his father's memorial tablet there amended to include her.

William Bradford Shipcott:

William was commonly known as "Bill" or "Willie". He was born in Belfast, Ireland, on September 6, 1905. His father, also WILLIAM BRADFORD SHIPCOTT, was born in Exeter, Devon, England, and later served as a leader of the "Orangemen", in Ireland, for the services of his Majesty, King George V. His father, William, Sr., lost his life on active service, in Ireland, in the early part of World War I. His mother, ELIZABETH McMILLIAN, was of Scott-Irish birth. She was born in Belfast, Ireland.

Being a woman of devoted Christian faith, she raised her two sons to recite and study the Bible. In 1924, she brought them to America, making Los Angeles Bible Institute Hotel, at 6th and Hope Streets, Los Angeles, California, their home. Both William and Harry studied music and Bible at the Biola Institute College. William took special interest in singing in the Gospel Quartet and the Men's Glee Club. Together with three other young men from the College, they organized a Men's Gospel Quartet in 1927 under the leadership of Professor Trowbridge. This Quartet toured the west coast from Southern California through Oregon and Washington, to Vancouver, Canada, and back, doing Gospel singing in churches and auditoriums. William was known as the "Irish Tenor". In January, 1928, William married Florence Idamae Rodman, whom he met at the Bible College, while taking the music course in 1927. They were married in Turlock, California, by the late Reverend Carl Lilliquist. Their marriage was blessed by the births of nine children. William took the name of William Bradford Shipcott, "Sr.", after the birth of his first child, who was named "William Bradford Shipcott, Jr.". He was a loving husband and father. He raised his children to have high standards and faith in God.

When the war broke out in 1941, William felt it his fervent duty to take some active part in service for the U. S. Government. He became a U. S. Citizen in 1942 and joined the U. S. Army Transportation Corp., out of Fort Mason, San Francisco, California. He served on ships, beginning October, 1942, in the South Pacific Theatre of Operations. Through 1943, William served as First Officer on Air Corp. Crash Boat, carrying Army personnel and supplies. In April, 1944, he was assigned to U. S. Army Ship Y-31, which was to serve in the European Theatre of Operations. In July, 1944, William was promoted to Master on Tanker Y-31, navigating the Channel Area from Cardiff, England, to France and Normandy, supplying fuel. In 1945, he served as Master on the U. S. Tanker Y-85, and brought the ship back to Charleston, South Carolina in November of that year. In December, 1945, "Emergency" still being declared by the U. S. Government, William was assigned back to the South Pacific area again. In March, 1946, he was given command of the U. S. Army Ship FS-319, serving War Crime Investigations. High commendations were given to Captain William Shipcott for his services well performed. In May, 1947, he served as Master of Ship FS-170 in locating graves of our War Dead in the South Pacific Islands until November of 1948. William was retired from the military from August of 1949 until May of 1950, when he went back into the service of the Military Sea Transport.

He sailed as an officer on the U.S.N.S. Barrett, and the U.S.N.S. Craig. A special high commendations was given to him for services of bravery performed while in charge of a Life-Boat saving operation that went to the rescue of passengers of a plane crash in the ocean near Japan. William served in the Military Sea Transport Service until October, 1953. He gave the best years of his life wholeheartedly in the service of our country. The last position William held was that of First Mate on the "Puerto Del Sol", a Merchant ship for the National Marine, Inc., sailing from San Diego to Peru, South America. He died in Obrero Hospital, Av. Buenos Aires, Piura, Peru, South America, at age 50, on September 8, 1955. The cause of death was "cirrhosis of the liver, and hemorrhage from rupture of esophageal varix", following a surgical operation.

FLORENCE IDA MAE RODMAN:

Florence was the mother of nine children. Shortly before her death, she wrote her "Memoires" on hundreds of scraps of

paper and gave them to her daughter-in-law, Barbara A. Shipcott (me)! to assemble and transcribe for her. Florence was a "stickler" about her writing. Every word that I wrote for her, she personally approved. This undertaking took her a couple of years to complete. In the end, she was very pleased with the Book of Memoires that I wrote for her. This book gives a fascinating insight into her family's fight for survival during the years of The Great Depression. Copies of this book were distributed among all her living children and became a part of the Rodman Family Reunion in 1990.

Below is a poem that Florence Rodman wrote for her mother when she was a young girl:

TO MOTHER RODMAN
by daughter Florence

My childhood days are ner' forgot
of your love my Mother Dear.
With your tender care you were always near
and your voice it comfort brought.

Those dear old songs you sang to me

LYDIA:

Lydia was born in the Philippines on September 9, 1917. She grew up there and later married a man by the last name of Arnaldo (we don't know his first name). They had two children, Jay and Penny. They later divorced.

Lydia met William "Bill" Bradford Shipcott in 1947. He lived with Lydia and her children in Manila from 1947 to 1949. Jay and Penny called him "Uncle Bill". Bill got stationed back in the USA in 1949, so he left the Philippines. He and Lydia corresponded for a while. They were planning to get married but Bill was still working on his divorce. There was a man at the church they attended that befriended Bill and offered to help him work out papers for Lydia and the children (including Precious) so they could join him in the USA. After some time passed, the letters stopped coming and they lost communication with Bill. Lydia and her children thought Bill had abandoned them. So after a few years passed, Lydia figured Bill wasn't coming back for them, so she remarried a man by the name of Garcia (first name unknown).

When Lydia remarried Garcia, he was angry at Bill Shipcott because he thought that Bill had abandoned his family, so he threw all the pictures and letters away. Lydia was only able to save two pictures and one letter that she scanned and sent to me in March 2002.

In the spring of 1954, Bill went back to the Philippines to get Lydia and the children, but it was too late. Lydia had already married another man by the name of Garcia. Bill told Lydia that he didn't leave them or intentionally lose touch with them, but that the man Bill trusted had betrayed him and was stealing letters and money that Bill had sent to fix the papers. Precious remembered that Bill put her on his lap and asked her to go back to the US to live with him, but she was so young and didn't know who he was so she didn't go with him. After Bill left, they didn't hear from him, probably because they moved. Lydia's husband, Garcia, died sometime after 1954.

Precious had two other-half-siblings, Jay and Penny, who were much older than her. Jay was 13 when Precious was born and Penny is only a year or two younger than Jay. Jay and Penny have loving memories of Bill. They absolutely loved and adored him. Penny said he was so nice and so sweet and loving to them. She remembers him well and the time that he lived with them in Manila. Lydia and her children knew that Bill had children, but they thought he only had one son and on daughter, because he had shown them a picture of the two children (it was probably the only one he had with him at the time).

Lydia must have been very disappointed and hurt when she thought that Bill had abandoned her and the children. But she never tried to give Precious a bad image of him. Instead, she always spoke highly of him and gave Precious every reason to be proud of her father and love her father just like he had been around her whole life despite circumstances, and even if she didn't get to know who he was.

Lydia wrote a letter to Precious (several months after she found out that Bill had died), explaining things to her. The following is an excerpt from that letter:

"We should come to be understanding and not press the blame on him nor me. I know, if he had only that chance to explain to you as he has always said when he was living, even in words (and) letters -- he would do all he can to fulfill his dreams for you...Truth always comes to the surface and really it did. Your Daddy Bill has always thought a lot of you. He had communicated with us but it never reached us....Not until the time when he came to see us in 1954, only to explain and made plans for you to come...and it never was done.

It was only this time on March 31, 1969, that I realized that all these could have been done, the dreams he has for you -- had he not passed away too soon. A lot of things could have happened had he been given the chance to live a little longer from the time he last saw you. I know him too well, to be true to his words. I realized then that he was that man who has always been firm with his words when he was living. Only the cruel years that drifted us apart has something to do with it. The communications that has tried to reach us and were missed were the most bitter of all.

Now that I have told you of how things happened and putting 2 and 2 together, after all, your Daddy Bill did not intentionally leave you hanging in the air. He had tried and failed because there was only a short time to make up for it -- from the last time he saw you in 1954 to the time he died in 1955."

Lydia's daughter, Precious, spent more than 30 years of her life trying to find her father's family in the US. It was until February, 2002, that her daughter, Joyce, continuing her mother's search for the family, that she made contact with Barbara Shipcott, the family historian, whom Joyce found via the Internet. It is very sad that Precious passed away in 2000 before the two families were able to contact each other.

In 1968, after her daughter, Precious, got married, Lydia left the Philippines and moved to New York. On March 31, 1969, Lydia learned that Bill had passed away in 1955. She lived in New York until 1983, and then moved down to Florida to be with her daughters, Precious and Penny. She was an awesome grandmother and also an excellent cook. She was a very private person and didn't discuss her past with anyone, even with her children and grandchildren.

In the early 1990s, Lydia began to show signs of Alzheimer's. By 1994, she was diagnosed with the disease and rapidly deteriorated. She passed away in July of 1998 due to complications from Alzheimer's.

Marriage Notes for WILLIAM SHIPCOTT and LYDIA ARNALDO:

Lydia and William Bradford Shipcott were never married as far as we know. Bill did file for a divorce from his first wife, Florence, but the divorce was never finalized.

Lydia and Bill lived together from 1947 to 1949 in Manila, Philippines. They had a daughter, Precious Elizabeth Shipcott, born May 9, 1949 in Manila.

JOHN GRANT SHIPCOTT:

John's middle name "Grant" was added in 1950 (his grandmother's maiden name, that was supposed to have been given at birth) and made official in 1958.

Although John was born at his grandparents' home in Coventry, he grew up at 47, Leys Avenue, Cambridge (1930 until 1947), Milton Road Junior and County High School. Met Office at RAF Oakington 9146-7, National Service 1948-1949 (British Zone of Germany during Berlin Air-Lift), Northolt (civil) airport 950-52; after marriage, lived Burridge, Southampton, (working Eastleigh airport) 1952-1959; RAF Mildenhall 1959-60, then posted to Camborne, Cornwall 1960. 1964, bought "The White House", Troon Village. Separated from Joan, later divorced, 1969.

After separation from his first wife Joan, John moved in with Joyce, who was by then divorced, and her two sons, at 31 Centenary St., Camborne, Cornwall; they were married a year later. Life was a financial struggle, but otherwise, apart from the separation from his children, it was heavenly for them. In 1973, they managed to afford to move to a bigger house at 11, Trehane Road, since then steady improvement has meant two holidays a year and new cars. In 1987, a six month tour of duty on Ascension Island paid for many house improvements and a new piano, and also increased John's pension. Subsequent retirement in 1989 has given John more time to devote to genealogy and other pastimes!

Precious was born in Manila, Philippines. Her mother was Lydia _____ and her father was William Bradford Shipcott. William Bradford Shipcott is listed as her father on her birth certificate, as well as her baptism record. She kept the Shipcott name until she got married in 1968, and even then never dropped her maiden name..she just sort of attached her husband's name..so she became Precious Elizabeth Shipcott Desuyo. The only time she didn't use Shipcott was when she was acting/modeling...she used a screen name of Elizabeth Garcia.

William Bradford Shipcott lived with Lydia and her children in Manila from 1947 to 1949. Jay and Penny called him "Uncle Bill". Bill got stationed back in the USA in 1949, so he left the Philippines. He and Lydia corresponded for a while. They were planning to get married but Bill was still working on his divorce. There was a man at the church they attended that befriended Bill and offered to help him work out papers for Lydia and the children (including Precious) so they could join him in the USA. After some time passed, the letters stopped coming and they lost communication with Bill. Lydia and her children thought Bill had abandoned them. So after a few years passed, Lydia figured Bill wasn't coming back for them, so she remarried a man by the name of Garcia (first name unknown).

When Lydia remarried Garcia, he was angry at Bill Shipcott because he thought that Bill had abandoned his family, so he threw all the pictures and letters away. Lydia was only able to save two pictures and one letter that she scanned and sent to me in March 2002.

In the spring of 1954, Bill went back to the Philippines to get Lydia and the children, but it was too late. Lydia had already married another man by the name of Garcia. Bill told Lydia that he didn't leave them or intentionally lose touch with them, but that the man Bill trusted had betrayed him and was stealing letters and money that Bill had sent to fix the papers. Precious remembered that Bill put her on his lap and asked her to go back to the US to live with him, but she was so young and didn't know who he was so she didn't go with him. After Bill left, they didn't hear from him, probably because they moved. Lydia's husband, Garcia, died sometime after 1954.

Precious had two other-half-siblings, Jay and Penny, who were much older than her. Jay was 13 when Precious was born and Penny is only a year or two younger than Jay. Jay and Penny have loving memories of Bill. They absolutely loved and adored him. Penny said he was so nice and so sweet and loving to them. She remembers him well and the time that he lived with them in Manila. Lydia and her children knew that Bill had children, but they thought he only had one son and on daughter, because he had shown them a picture of the two children (it was probably the only one he had with him at the time).

Precious started acting/modeling when she was 12 years old (and stopped when she married Jim Desuyo in 1968. They had four children: Jennifer Joan (aka Jinky) - her last name now is Dalisay; Javelyn Jane (aka J-lyn) - her name now is Oberes; Jame "Joyce" - her last name now is Ormeo; and Jason "James" - he is also married.

For the most part, Precious was a housewife (at least while in the Philippines). She may have worked, but it was before James and Joyce were born. Joyce thinks they owned some kind of clothing shop. She thinks Precious designed dresses or something like that. She knows she didn't make clothes because Precious couldn't sew.

The family left the Philippines and came to the US on March 23, 1983. Precious originally planned on living in California (Lydia's family lived there.) So they lived in El Monte, CA for a few weeks. Then Precious and Jim decided to move to Jacksonville, FL (where Jim's family lives).

Precious lived in Jacksonville, FL with her children while Jim lived in the Philippines because he was working at World Vision and that's where he was based. They lived apart for a while. Jim would visit every year. Precious started working odd jobs to keep herself busy and also to help Jim support the family. It was a rough beginning for a while. Precious lived in Florida with Jinky, Joyce and James. J-lyn lived in the Philippines with Jim. So Lydia (Precious' mother) moved down to FL to help with the kids. Precious didn't know how to drive, so she had to find jobs that were in walking distance from home. She worked at Krispy Kreme and Jefferson Ward (later known as Montgomery Ward).

Precious eventually learned how to drive and got a car. Then in 1987, she started working at Blue Cross Blue Shield as a Provider Rep. (She worked there until she passed away). Then in 1989, Jim and J-lyn moved to FL with the rest of the family. In 1990, Precious and Jim decided to buy a house and that was pretty much their only other move. They lived in Jacksonville, FL since 1983 - same side of town - and in the same house since 1990. The only (temporary) move they ever made since then, was when their house burned down in the summer of 1999 - they had to move to an apartment while the house was being rebuilt.

Precious and her family joined The First Baptist Church of Argyle in 1992. She was very active at church and very active in the choir (she was an Alto). Precious and Jim raised their kids in a loving Christian home. She was an awesome Christian lady who was so full of joy even in her death bed. She was always the one at church to approach every visitor and made sure they felt welcome.

In May of 2000, Precious was diagnosed with Small Cell Carcinoma (Lung cancer). It was already in its advanced/final stages. Her doctor said she would have 4-6 months left at the most. The cancer was not due to smoking as Precious never smoked in her life. She tried chemo, but it didn't do anything at all...then she underwent radiation everyday up until a few days before she passed away. She thought she was having the radiation because it was making her cancer better, but the doctors did it for quality of life. (Her tumors were rapped around her spine -- that's why she couldn't walk and also around her neck. He did radiation to keep the tumor from choking her). The family did not tell her that she had terminal cancer. She was not told until just a few days before she died. She died on October 10, 2000 and was buried on October 14, 2000.

Precious was a very special person. Everyone loved her. She had a really great sense of humor. She is deeply missed by her family.
